

The APR Form used for annual reporting has changed. In brief, the changes made to the APR will not change the essence of the data being collected; however, many of the questions will have slightly different response options or new variants.

The new APR will *not* affect any APRs submitted *prior to* March 17th, 2009. However, all projects that have entered data in an APR created after March 17th or have submitted an APR after this date will need to ensure that the data in the new APR form is accurate and complete. Specifically, we have translated the data from the old form to the new form when feasible, but project directors must carefully review all questions in the new form and correct responses if necessary. For questions where the data are not translated, new data must be entered. Projects are ultimately responsible for the accuracy of their data!
